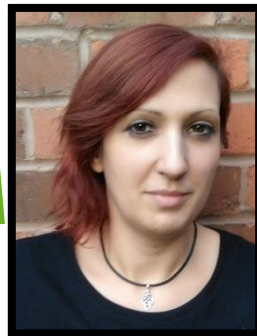

Bench added to woodland walk

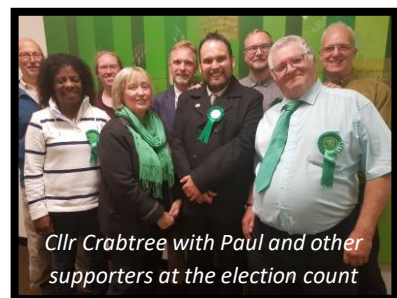
